9 Questions for Planning a Training Session

- 1. Who will be participating in the training? Include the number expected and a brief profile.
- 2. Why is the training needed? Explain the situation that demands such training.
- 3. When will the training occur? Identify the dates and times for the training.
- 4. Where will the training take place? Identify the location for the training.
- 5. What content will be taught? List the specific skills and knowledge to be taught.
- 6. What objectives will be achieved by the end of the training? Write learner-centered objectives.
- 7. What supplies will be needed? List materials needed for the training.
- 8. What costs will be involved? Identify the expenses for the training.
- 9. How will the training take place? Develop learning tasks for each objective.

Costs: Members will be responsible for purchasing the materials for the pen they choose to build; a list of supplies will accompany each design.
